### To Operate Clock

Blinking Display/Alarm On Indicator

When the clock is plugged in, the display will blink on and off meaning the incorrect time is being displayed. You should always check the time when this is indicated. When the Alarm Indicator (7) is on, the alarm will sound at the time set. Set Time

To set the time, press the TIME SET button (4) and the HOUR SET button (2) until the correct hour is displayed, then release the HOUR SET button and press the MINUTE SET button (3) until the correct time is displayed.

### Set Alarm

To set the alarm time, press and hold the ALARM SET button (5) and the HOUR SET (2) or MINUTE SET button (3) as above. Snooze

Touch the SNOOZE botton (1) and get an extra 9 mimutes of sleep. This may be repeated up to six times within one hour.

#### To Operate Alarm

Slide the ON/OFF switch (6) located on the *clock* to the ON posttlon. The alarm will sound at the time set. To shut off the alarm for longer times, slide the ON/OFF switch (6) to the OFF position. Set Time Mode

Slide the 12124 hour switch (8) located on the control panel to 12 or 24 hour position. The time will show American time format with AM/PM indicator in 12 hour position or European time format in 24 hour position. Battery Back-up (BATTERY NOT INCLUDED) Located on the back of the clock *Is a battery* hatch which can be easily removed. Inside is a 9 volt transistor battery connector - A battery, such

be easily removed. Inside is a 9 volt transistor battery connector - A battery, such as Eveready No. 216 or equivalent, may be installed or changed without unplugging the *clock from* the lime. The battery will keep time if the power ever fails but the display will not show. But don't wory, we'll still get you up because the alarm will still sound.

If you have a long power failure, the clock uses an internal clock that Is less accurate than the line frequency. You may need to make a slight adjustment in this case. Just follow the "Time Set" instructions. The alarm will be correct.
